## Young Musicians Scholarship Awards Rules

---

The Musicians Club of Orange County is offering music students currently in their senior year of high school or in college a chance to win one of four \$1000 scholarships to help with furthering their studies. The winners of the Musicians Club of Orange County Young Musicians Scholarship Awards Competition will also be offered an opportunity to perform at a concert held at the Milton Foster Recital Hall in Santa Ana in the spring of each year.

### Eligibility

The Competition is open to all legal residents of Orange County who are full-time students studying in the U.S. and are 16-22 years of age at the time of entry ("Applicant"). Employees of AFM Local 7 and members of their immediate families (spouses, parents, children, and siblings, and their respective spouses) or households (whether related or not) are ineligible to enter and win. By participating in this Competition, applicants agree to these Official Rules. All decisions of the Competition judges are final and binding.

### Application Period

The Application Period begins March 1, 2024 and ends April 5, 2024 at 11:59:59 p.m.

### How to Enter

1. During the Application Period, Applicants must submit, via email to President Edmund Velasco at [Edmund@musicianscluboc.org](mailto:Edmund@musicianscluboc.org) : a completed Application, a letter of recommendation from either a private or school/college teacher, a personal statement of the Applicant's goals as a professional musician or music teacher, and a link to a YouTube video as described below. An Applicant who wishes to apply for more than one Award Category or on multiple instruments can do so on the same Application.
2. Each applicant must submit a video recording featuring themselves performing as a soloist, with accompaniment if applicable. The video should be no more than 10 minutes long and include examples of at least two contrasting styles and eras (example: classical era, romantic era, fast, ballad). The titles and composers of each submitted recording must be included in the file name of the uploaded files. This video explains how to upload and share a private YouTube video:

### Judging Process

Following the Application Period, all submissions will be judged by a panel of three professional musicians who will determine the winners. Videos will be removed from YouTube after judging. Winners will be notified within 30 days of the end of the Application Period.
